R.N.B.C. 'JIG'

A party known as 'J' 1 was hastily embodied and to meet a last minute commitment in Operation Torch, from which they returned to FOLIOT where they became part of the Pool. Meanwhile 'J' 2 and 'J' 3 formed in ARMADILO in January 1943. They moved on to exercise comitments elsewhere, until a completely new 'J' 1 which was trained during May, joined them at Inveraray by 13th January 1943.

Took part in exercise "Jantzen" in July 1943.

Came to Armadillo in February 1944 en route to H.M.S. HOPETOUN where they remained till they moved South to participate in "OVERLORD" under Force 'G'. Returned to ARMADIHO in September, 1944 thereafter moving to St.Clement 1st October 1944. The unit moved to Mylodon in January 1945 and to DUNDONALD I in December 1945.
