R.N.B.C. 'LOVE'

Formed at Inverary November 1942 thereafter carrying out exercise commitments at BRONTOSAURUS, VECTIS and other Southern bases. Worked under Force J throughout most of 1943, with the exception of a fortnight at ARMADILLO in June and a period at Achnacarry at the beginning of July.

Proceeded to Normandy with Force 'J', one half working till sometime about the beginning of August, the remainder working till 7th September.
