Formed at Armadillo May - June 1943.
 There were no ~~COOCCOCCOCCO~~ Lieutenants available and the three S.Lts. were senior to the Seven Midshipmen by virtue of age only. However thanks to to the keenness of the officers the loyal and hardworking co-operation of the Petty Officers and Leading Seamen and above all to the absence of the disturbing older hands from barracks, this unit set about its work with great zest.

On completion of training Roger One was engaged for about a month in the production of N.B.C. film at Gales Camp.

After the usual exercises at Inverary, Kilbride etc., the whole unit moved to Ayr and then on to join Force S at Strathpeffer.

Proceeded to Normandy with Force 'S' and on return after a period at Armadillo proceeded to Folkestone where it remained until transferred to MYLONDON in April 1945
