R.N.B.C. 'SUGAR'

Formed at ARMADILLO in July - August 1943 after the first two sub units had been absorbed into H.O. P and Q which were being prepared for foreign draft. Proceeded to Gales Camp where they worked with 7th and 8th Beach Group before moving with the 8th Brigade of 3rd Canadian Division at Inverary in September on the conclusion of which they moved via ARMADILLO to Turtle where they came under the orders of Force J (GJ.2) S.1 and S.3 landed with the assault troops on D Day,

On return to ARMADILLO disbanded as much below strength
