R.N.B.C. "TARE"

Formed at Armadillo August- September 1943,
 Lt. J.E.M. Mitchell, R.N.V.R. as Senior Officer
 After various exercises at Gales and Inverary the unit
 spent most of the winter with its Beach Group (No.9 ?)
 in Monckland Camp, Ayrshire, until it moved in
 February to Inverary for 50th Division Assault training.
 After a brief visit to Armadillo proceeded 28th and
 29th March to Portland to join Force G with whom it landed
 in Normandy. Despite the fact that some of its officers
 and men had to land before H Hour on the AVRE tanks
 to help establish signal link no casualties were
 sustained, though one officer and one rating were in an
 LCT (A) which sank on the way across.

After a short period at Armadillo the unit moved to
 DUNDONALD about 20th August and thence to Mylodon in
 December 1944 or January 1945 where it remained until
 disbanded.
