Formed September 1943 in Armadillo did not show up too well in initial training and subsequent exercises because of the bad influence of a number of G.S. Ratings.

Remained in Aramdillo, Gailes Inverary or Brontosaurus until July 1944 when moved to Foliot thence to NYLUDON before returning to Armadillo on 2nd Jan 1945 for embarkation for S.E.A.C. on 5th, 7th Jan 1945.

Took part in Malaya landings September 1945 and were disbanded on Sation during the following month.
